The Crosby County Leadership Advisory Board and the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in Crosby County will host the "Crosby County Business Expo" on November 20, 2014 at the Pioneer Memorial Building in Crosbyton. In return, all businesses will be included in a printed directory, which will be given to each attendee at the expo. Everyone attending the expo will also be provided a meal at no charge.
